Calblanque, Monte de las Cenizas y Peña del Águila Regional Park

It encompasses some 2800 HA and is found situated at the eastern end of the coast of the Region of Murcia, between Portmán and Cabo de Palos.

In this protected area, you will find beaches, woodlands, shrublands, dry riverbeds and cliffs. The great variety of these environments allows them to be inhabited by numerous species of flora and fauna; some threatened or highly exclusive, such as the Cartagena Cypress, the Cartagena Rock Rose, the Spanish Toothcarp or the Bonelli's Eagle.

Its geological diversity and cultural heritage also stand out, given that it exhibits such features as Las Cenizas Military Battery and the Roman Road, and features that display salt making, agricultural and mining traditions.

There are no water and food outlets within the Regional Park. For these services we recommend you visit the nearest municipalities as Los Belones, Cabo de Palos or Portmán.

During your visit...

- Leave your vehicle in the dedicated car parks.
- Always walk on authorised walkways and trails, creating shortcuts deteriorates the soil.
- Take responsibility for the waste you generate, use containers located in the park entrance. Remember that butts and food are also garbage.
- Respect the flora and fauna, gathering and collecting is not permitted.
- The lands of the the Regional Park are almost all private property.
- Avoid making noise as it disturbs animals and other visitors.
- Carry your pet tied and remember collect their excrement. The municipal regulation does not allow the presence of pets in beaches throughout the year.
- Remember that making fires is prohibited.
- Call 112 if you see a sea turtle or its tracks or any other injured or dead anima.

FOSSIL DUNE TRAIL

This short trail, will bring you close to an ancient seabed declared a "Geomorphological Reservation Zone"

Type: Circular
Distance: 2 km
Estimated time: 25 min.
Start and end: El Atochar car park
Difficulty: Low

MINING TRAIL

Within the forest of Pines and Cypress of Cartagena, you will find the signs of mining activity.

Type: Linear
Estimated distance and time: 2 km 35 mins*
Start: Detour on PR-MU3 (on the RM-F42)
End: Peña del Águila Viewpoint
Difficulty: Medium
